

Environmental Policy

GMC Surveying is committed to the protection and sustainability of the environment and the reduction of greenhouse gas emissions and waste resulting from its work activities.

It is the policy of GMC Surveying to make every reasonable effort to identify environmental aspects, prevent impacts, protect the environment and implement strategies aimed at the reduction of environmentally impacting work practices. This may include the use of technology to enhance our commitment to sustainable resource use (reduce paper use) and ensuring project activities are mindful and protective of local flora and fauna habitats.

GMC Surveying is committed to improving its environmental performance by aiming to have "No Environmental Harm" resulting from its operational activities.

GMC Surveying Environmental Policy is to:

- Comply with relevant environmental legislation, including acts, regulations, notices, standards and codes of practice and ensure that any changes to legislation, including acts, regulations, notices, standards and codes of practice that affect GMC Surveying, its workers and the environment will be communicated accordingly.
- Provide suitable resources to ensure that the Environmental System is maintained and continually improved, and that aspects and impacts are effectively identified, controlled and mitigated.
- Set companywide objectives and targets that meet the requirements of this Policy. Objectives and targets will be continually monitored and measured and organisational progress towards these targets reported to management on a bi-annual basis. The measurement of objectives and targets will form the basis for continual improvement initiatives across the GMC Surveying organisation to reduce and eliminate environmental harm.
- Ensure that all workers understand their environmental obligations and responsibilities of this Policy through inductions, training, position descriptions, provision of environmental materials and other methods deemed necessary by management.
- Review this Policy by management on an annual basis in order to establish and maintain its relevance and appropriateness in meeting the GMC Surveying objectives and targets and relevance to the organisations environmental activities.

It is the responsibility and expectation that all GMC Surveying staff will actively promote and implement the objectives of this policy and work toward **"No Environmental Harm".**
